- c. Up to \$10,000 for Health Literacy grants

SSCPP Mini Grant "Health is Wealth!" Outcome Report

Bridgewater Patient Advocacy and Wellness PLLC

- Dr. Jim O'Neil provided a summary of the activities supported by CHNA23 for the "Health is Wealth" Health Literacy program.
- Per the initial grant request 11 presentations were provided across 7 towns within geography.
- Objectives for the Health is Wealth segments of the programming were well received with satisfaction in near 100% of responders. A total of 63 individuals attended the lecture series which were conducted in public libraries, Councils of Aging and Health Fair.
- In the "Fit to a T" Osteoporosis program it was noteworthy that most attendees all had suffered a broken bone or were medically identified as at risk or actually having Osteoporosis. Few men and only one person under 50 years of age attended the sessions. Program and materials were rated "Excellent" by 85% of participants.
- Jim found that it was most effective to present to a group that was already assembled – i.e. men's breakfast group at Plymouth COA.

Plymouth County Sheriff's Department Presentation: Programming & Resources

George Gorgizian, Infectious Disease Coordinator

George gave an extensive report of programs available thru the Plymouth Sheriff's office, both to the community and for the inmates. Attendees had a lot of questions about how to avail themselves of the community programs. Programs for inmates focus on re-entry, as the vast majority of the incarcerated are serving sentences of 30 months or less.
