- Also held three Mental Health First Aid Trainings.
- Will be working on revising grants and will have two major grants available for next year for \$25,000.

Video Presentation: Removing Obstacles to Health Care for People with Disabilities

- Donna Rodriguez of PACTV shared the video project "Improving Healthcare for People with Disabilities" created in partnership with SSCPP, the Arc of Greater Plymouth, DDS and the Nemasket Group. Bobbi Martino worked very hard to spearhead the video. Maureen King was also a key member and was available to share an update and answer questions.
- The goal of the video is to start a conversation. It was produced to illustrate the importance of clear communications between health providers and consumers. Our Health Literacy Initiative has prioritized improving health outcomes for special and vulnerable populations, and we hope that this video is a good first step in that direction.

Mini Grant Outcome Report

Donna Keller & Danielle Young presented the outcomes of SSCPP funded Old Colony YMCA Physical Activity/Making Healthy Choices grant.

- Program was put on at Carver Elementary School and Plymouth YMCA preschool. Also did a staff training.
- Used BOKS curriculum through Reebok (Building Our Kids Successes).
- 10 week after school program with physical activity and nutrition component.
- 50 children participated and over half were kindergarteners.

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Health Literacy Update

Health Literacy Coordinator, Mimi MacDonald shared an update on the year's progress and plans moving forward.

- Reviewed common themes identified at World Café.
- Have added a glossary of health literacy terms to website. Also created a resource library for website. Will be working to make website more user-friendly.
- October was proclaimed Health Literacy Month in MA.
- Went to health literacy plain language training and will be working with the ESOL program at the Plymouth Library in the fall.

The floor was opened for agency announcements.

The next meeting is scheduled for **September 13th**.
